Discussion and Decisions:

1. Mark read the minutes from the previous meeting.
2. **Fundraising:** Ms. Kenny has talked to Ms. Hurley and have agreed not to do the arts and crafts bake sale this year as it would be too rushed. We will try to do it in late November/Early December next year. This year we will hold 3 Christmas jumper days for charity on each of the Fridays leading up to Christmas. The chosen charities are the Children's Health Foundation, Sligo Social Services and Sligo Cancer Support Centre. We will sing Christmas Carols outside the school and donations will be collected in buckets as pupils come into school.
